1800 RESPECT

1800RESPECT provides 24 hours a day support for sexual assault, domestic and family violence. It is a confidential information, counselling and referral service.

Domestic violence takes many forms and can include physical, sexual, financial, social or emotional abuse. It can involve a current or former partner, family member, carer or another person you are close to.

It is never ok for someone you know to:

- 👊 Hit, kick and do other things that hurt your body.
 - 👊 Touch you in ways you do not want to be touched.
 - 👊 Say and do things that make you feel scared or unsafe.
 - 👊 Take your money or use money to make your life hard.
 - 👊 Tell you they will hurt you, your children, other people you care about or your pets. When calling 1800RESPECT, you can give as much or as

little information on about yourself as you want. You will have access to qualified and experienced professionals. You can also contact them if you are concerned about someone you know and would like to help.

Our values of RESPECT and BELONGING will be the foundation on for our work to turn young people in our care into caring respectful adults, regardless of their background.
