What is Project Ready?

Project Ready is a hands-on life and work readiness program designed to help you get ready for your future world of work. If you could use some help choosing a career path, building self-confidence and gaining skills to successfully transition into the workforce or further training, Project Ready is for you!

Project Ready is a full-year VET program that includes a Certificate II, so you will graduate with recognition for up to two units at 1 and 2 level for VCE or VCAL. What a great head start!

Project Ready is not like regular school. The program is run by a facilitator with experience in youth programs and social work. Their job is to make Project Ready interactive, fun, engaging and inspiring.

How does Project Ready support you to become life and work ready?

Project Ready supports you by:

- ▶ Building 'groupness'; a group space where you feel comfortable to personally develop
- ▶ Helping you discover your unique skills and strengths so you can plan for your career
- ▶ Helping you understand possible training and work pathways through a range of career development and industry engagement activities
- ▶ Building resilience through personal development activities, volunteering and community involvement
- ▶ Improving your communication skills
- ▶ Teaching you work readiness skills, such as the job application process
- ▶ Teaching you enterprise and entrepreneurial skills
- ▶ Teaching you workplace health and safety skills
- ▶ Facilitating work placement opportunities
